General anesthesia relaxes the muscles in your digestive tract and airway that keep food and acid from passing from your stomach into your lungs. Always follow your doctor's instructions about avoiding food and drink before surgery. Fasting is usually necessary starting about six hours before your surgery.

A light meal or nonhuman milk may be ingested for up to 6 h before elective procedures requiring general anesthesia, regional anesthesia, or procedural sedation and analgesia. §§ Additional fasting time (e.g. , 8 or more hours) may be needed in cases of patient intake of fried foods, fatty foods, or meat.

The Surgical Risk Score assigns a numerical value to reflect the risk level associated with the procedure ranging from 1 (very low risk) to 5 (very high risk). These categories identify operations with increased potential for substantial blood loss or other intraoperative and postoperative risks.

If the same anesthesia CPT code applies to two or more of the surgical procedures, billers enter the anesthesia code and the number of surgeries to which the modified CPT code applies.
