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Community College Math Placement Test

The Math Placement Test is a multiple choice exam in which you are required to answer every question. It is given on a computer. When taking the Placement Test, you cannot return to a previous question, so please make every effort to accurately choose your answers. You may use a calculator.

The Math Test - Placement Testing - Nassau Community College

The College Placement Test (CPT) provides an assessment of every incoming student’s basic skill levels in Mathematics, Reading and Writing. The result of your Placement Test will establish whether you enter a college Algebra course, spend a semester in a Remedial course of study or place out of the initial College Algebra class.

When an institution of higher learning is trying to determine the math skills of a given student, they normally use that student’s college placement test scores. These rigorous exams test on a wide range of math concepts and the final scores are considered an effective measure of their skill level.

TCC uses the ALEKS Placement, Preparation and Learning (ALEKS PPL) Assessment to determine readiness for mathematics courses. ALEKS PPL is an adaptive web-based program that can map a student’s strengths and weaknesses. The Placement Assessment has up to 30 questions and generally takes 60-90 minutes to complete.

Placement Testing: Students who are not exempt from testing based on one or more of the options below will need to take the placement test to see what English, reading and math courses they are eligible for. These tests are very important! Think of them as your opportunity to show how ready you are for college level courses.

Prior to registering for courses, most students attending Nassau Community College will be required to take a computerized placement test called Accuplacer. This test will be used to determine the appropriate level of course work for you to begin your studies at Nassau Community College.

Students may take this test and register for an appropriate math course with approval from an advisor. Placement Evidence. Depending on the requirements you meet, there are three different ways to place into your first math class at WCC. Use Academic Records If you have a Whatcom County high school transcript from within the last 1-2 years, or a previous college transcript which includes math coursework, speak to an advisor to get placed appropriately.

Placement testing: Since English, math Virginia Placement Tests (VPT) and Accuplacer English placement tests are not designed to be given without a proctor, alternative criteria will be used to determine course placements. Alternative criteria may include a combination of existing grades and measured competencies.

Taking math assessment tests Pay the \$35 Advanced math Assessment fee in Marketplace or Cashier (where available). The \$35 fee includes up to 5 attempts at the placement test and gives you access to the ALEKS system for review and practice. Allow a minimum of hour and a half to complete your test.

The mathematics placement testing includes elementary algebra to start. If you score a 76 or higher on elementary algebra questions, Accuplacer will automatically continue into college-level mathematics questions. Once you begin answering these questions, your placement is based on your score in this portion of the exam.
